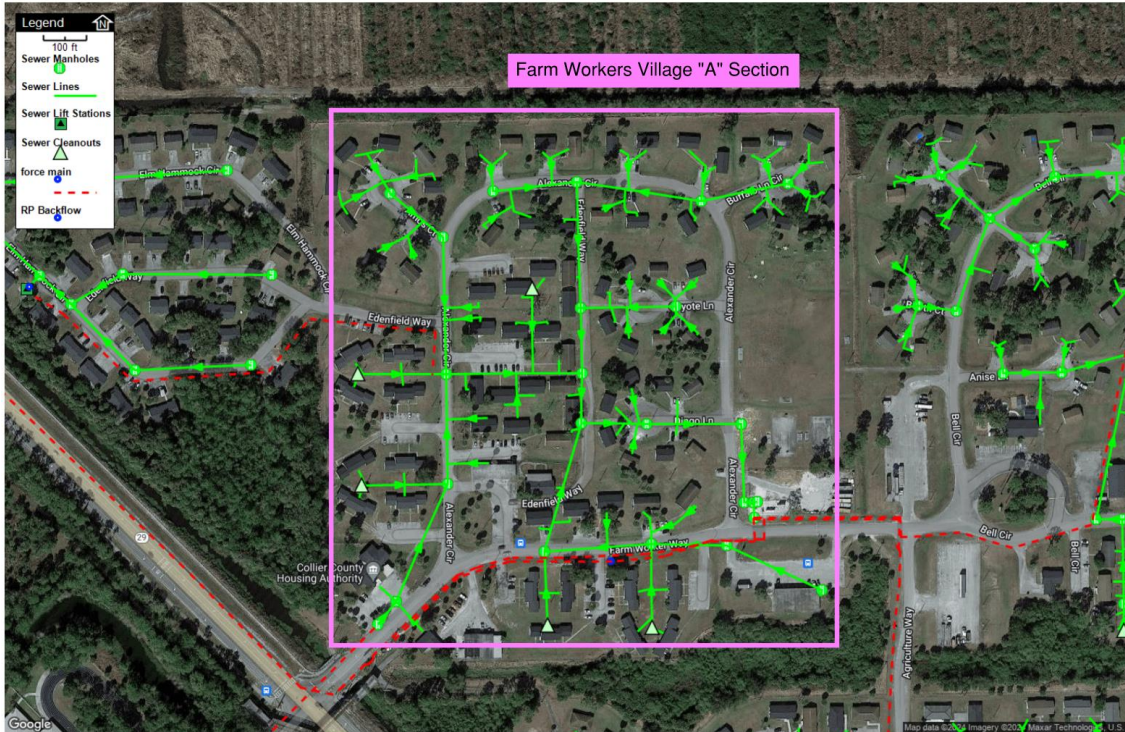
- **Bid Award is anticipated to be approved by the Board at the April 2, 2025, Board Meeting at 3:30 PM.**

2) **Project Overview & Site Walk**

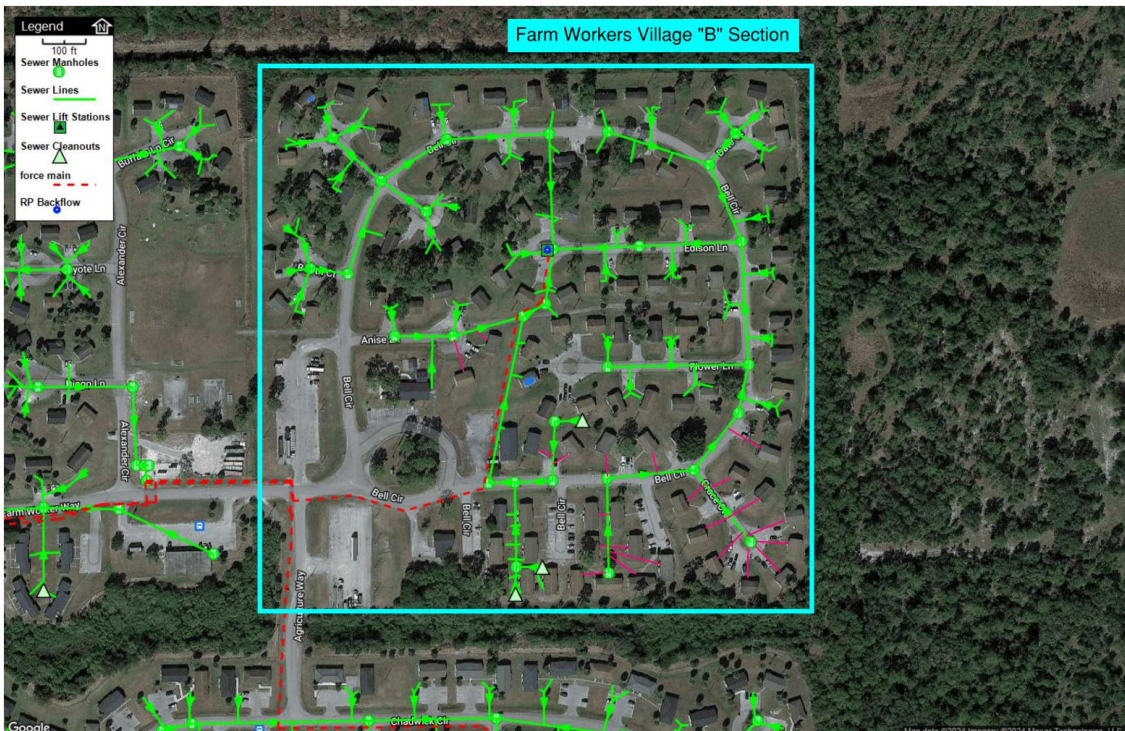
- **Project Overview**
 - Upgrade approximately 10,000 LF of 8” Clay Sewer Pipe, approximately 192 4” or 6” sewer service laterals using cured in place pipe lining (CIPP) methodology
 - Location of Work is Farm Worker Village Section A and B, located at 1800 Farm Worker Way, Immokalee, FL 34142
 - Project Substantially Completion within 60 business days and Final Completion within 90 days of issuance of the Notice to Proceed
 - Project is funded through a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) by Collier County. Bidders should review the grant funding requirements contained in the ITB package.

- This project will be fully funded by the grant and the bid must cover the entire project not to exceed the grant award amount of \$1,263,000.00.
